To Inspect:


- 1. Flush the pump with fresh water and disinfectant.
- 2. Close the maintenance valves (if installed) in the inlet and outlet piping.
- 3. Turn off/disconnect electrical source to the pump motor.
- 4. Disassemble the inlet/outlet flanges, elbows, and valve housings.
- 5. Remove the four (4) duckbill valves. Replace all valves if any appear to be swollen, out of shape, torn, scuffed, slit or show any other sign of wear.

CAUTION: Be sure to use black duckbill valves (part number 385311581) for all sewage applications.

Use red duckbill valves made of nitrile (part number 385311582) for oil-contaminated water applications.

To Install:

- 1. Insert the two (2) inlet valves pointing toward the pump body.
- 2. Insert the two (2) outlet valves pointing away from the pump body.
